Markaz-e-Umeed, school for special needs children was established in 1971. At a time when there were no Departments at the Government level for Special persons (set up in 1985) and no visible efforts for the recognition of disabled population, the Markaz was set up as a special initiative at Karimabad where it still stands today and where there are still very few or no schools for children with disabilities. It's founder, Mr. Imdad Siddiqui, began this noble endeavor with a strength of only 5 students. To date, Markaz-e-Umeed has helped more than 10,000 poor, innocent Special Students get Special education & training over the past 45 years. Our prized asset is the pool of Markaz supported students who are today trained and live a near normal life without becoming a burden on their families and on the country.

Today the school caters to the needs of over 200 special needs children, those who suffer from mental and physical disabilities.

Since the last 4 decades, Markaz-e-Umeed like its name has been spreading the light of hope for many special needs children who otherwise had none. Our team, especially our teachers who are all specialized in the field are striving daily to provide free-of-cost education with love and care to children with disabilities at the Markaz.

As per the concept of its founder Mr. Imdad Siddiqui, The Markaz, provides a very peaceful environment with its spacious lawns filled with greenery, flowers and butterflies and swings for special needs children. Also, we work to help the children (slow learners) in finding for themselves useful means of employing their skills thus becoming useful members of their household and society.

Mr. Siddiqui's legacy has been very successfully continued by his family over 4 decades.

4. Active participation in raising awareness campaigns and educational occasions that target to change negative social trends about children with special needs to help reach social integration.
5. Establishing curricular, extracurricular and recreational activities.
6. Giving opportunities for children with special needs to merge with community members and provide social services.
7. Train professional personnel in the field of special education.

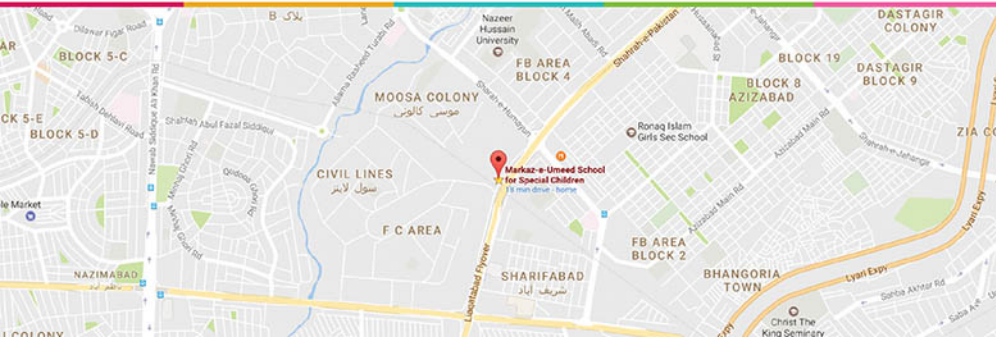

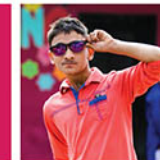

- Including the Excluded: A special seminar held at Beach luxury hotel with the support of Chairman, Mr. Byram Avari, to mark World Disability Day, an international day observed around the world in recognition and celebration of special needs people. Also, the event's purpose was to bring together seasoned professionals from healthcare, law, education and social work who are willing to take initiatives for the progress of inclusive society. Markaz management has the privilege of having Mr. Haider Imam Rizvi as its member and a highly experienced professional who will head the committee.

ACCOMPLISHMENTS-2011-12

- AGP's calendar for 2011: A special awareness initiative implemented in support for special needs children by team of Ali Gohar (Pvt.) Ltd. Special paintings were created by children and teachers for Markaz on individual themes for 12 months and will be printed on each month's page with a small description about the student who worked on it. The calendar will be sent out to 10,000 medical professionals and related individuals and will thus serve the purpose of awareness about Markaz-e-Umeed's endeavours a great deal.
- Social Expo 2012- A mega-event being organized in acknowledgement of social activism in Pakistan at Expo center, Karachi. The occasion is held on 3rd of March, 2012. 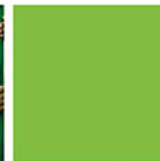
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ACCOMPLISHMENTS-2012-13

- Monthly Parents meet up



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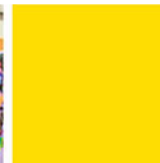
ACCOMPLISHMENTS 2015-16

CURRENT ACHIEVEMENTS

- One year on campus job training for capable students. Afterwards referred to other suitable places for employment. 16 special needs children (6 girls and remaining boys) from the school have been supported through this training and employment help program.
- On-going campaigns and co-ordination with donor segment to further strengthen sustainability for our services as well as required resources.
- Special awareness events to continue raising the level of understanding and educating the masses further about the rights and importance of special needs children.



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- YES Program: Internees from YES program conducted different activities and sessions including C2C project.
- The Rotary Club of Karachi: Members from its team participated in different occasions of Markaz-e-Umeed including Social Expo 2016.
- Internees from University of Toronto: Also engaged themselves in summer internship program at Markaz-e-Umeed.
- Autism Unit: We plan to start Autism Unit for students of autism and moderate to severe learning challenges into mainstream education. Autism program offers a variety of therapeutic and support services to infants and toddlers with disabilities and their families. The services include family education and counseling; home visits and parents support groups, speech pathology and audiology, occupational therapy, physical therapy, psychological services, nutrition services, assistive technology devices and services. Markaz-e-Umeed associated with Dr. Danish Saleheen MBBS, PhD, University of Pennsylvania Markaz-e-Umeed on his research of autistic children. He has leading number of research projects in Pakistan.
- Markaz-e-Umeed requires an extension in its on-going educational programme for 50 students who are currently among its waiting list of new applicants. Up to 500 applications are already on the list. Markaz frequently receives applications for admission and in this regard, we plan to approach donor agencies willing to support this project.
- Continue awareness efforts on higher scale through various media events.
- Classroom to Corporate C2C: An initiative taken by Markaz-e-Umeed to empower girls of less privileged areas and reach their full potential. This free of cost English Language and personal career development program of Markaz-e-Umeed ensures that every girl has an opportunity to learn and succeed because we all believe that to invest in girl's education benefits everyone.
